## PLEASE BE AWARE THAT OUR LUNCH PROCEDURES HAVE CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS. All students will eat lunches in the Garden Terrace Cafe near the museum galleries.

You have been assigned a lunch time that corresponds with your arrival and lesson time at the Getty Center. Seating in the Garden Terrace Cafe is limited, so please adhere to your assigned lunch time. Please make certain all adults accompanying the field trip are aware of your group's lunch time.

**Students should bring their lunches in small, disposable bags.** Larger bags, backpacks, and other containers that do not fit in the coolers should be stowed on the bus or in cars.

Students should carry their lunches in hand when exiting the bus and riding the tram. Lunch coolers brought from the school can be carried by teachers and chaperones, and should be placed in laps or seats, not the floor, of the tram.

When you exit the tram at the top of the hill, your next steps depend on your tour time.

## • Groups with Docent tours 10:15-11:15 and 10:45-11:45

- Deposit your lunches in the provided white coolers, which Getty staff will move to the Garden Terrace Cafe once your lunches are stowed. Your coolers will be labeled with your school's name and you can pick up lunches there at your lunch time.

## • Groups with Docent tours 11:45-12:45 and 12:15-1:15

- Carry your lunches to the Garden Terrace Cafe to have lunch. Our staff will direct you to the Cafe. Coolers marked with your school's name will be available for leftovers which can be picked up at the same location before you leave to return to school. Please return to the tram arrival plaza 5-10 minutes before your scheduled tour time.

## Additional lunch options include:

**Box lunches**—Teachers can preorder box lunches for students. Please contact Bon Appétit's catering department at (310) 440-6213 or bonappetit@getty.edu for current prices and menus.

**Cafe**—School groups may purchase their lunches in the Cafe, which opens daily at 11:30 a.m. We ask that teachers and chaperones stagger the arrival of their groups to avoid overcrowding in the Cafe. In addition, students must stay in their chaperone-led groups during their entire visit, including while eating lunch in the Cafe.

**Coffee Carts**—If you need to purchase food before the Cafe opens at 11:30 a.m., there are two coffee carts located at the Getty Center, one in the Museum Courtyard and the other to the right of the main museum entrance. Open Tuesday through Sunday, these carts offer beverages, pastries, and other snack items.
