eduroam

eduroam (education roaming) is an international roaming Wi-Fi service for users in research and higher education. It provides researchers, teachers, and students easy and secure Internet access when visiting an institution other than their own.



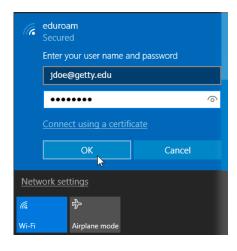
Getty offers eduroam at all sites to enable visitors from participating institutions secure Internet access; and when Getty staff are visiting or working at other eduroam participant sites, they can easily obtain the same secure Internet access without needing to inquire as to local Wi-Fi network credentials.

Note: eduroam does not provide access to Getty network servers or services; it simply offers secure Internet access.

eduroam works equally well on PC or Mac laptops and mobile devices such as iPhones and iPads – both Getty-provided and personally owned. Logging in is easy – and there is no fee. Simply:

- 1. Locate the **eduroam** wireless network in your device's Wi-Fi settings.
- 2. Enter your full Getty e-mail address (jdoe@getty.edu).
- 3. Enter your Getty OneID password.
- 4. When prompted, accept a certificate, and you will have a secure connection to the Internet.
